INDEX FINDINGS FROM STUDENTS AND STAFF WHO TEACH IN HIGHER EDUCATION

National Forum for the Enhancement of Teaching and Learning in Higher Education

Survey conducted in Oct/Nov 2019

48% of students and 68% of staff who teach stated that they would like digital technologies in T&L to be used more than they are now

70% of staff who teach had never taught in a live online environment (compares with 74% in the UK)

...and then...COVID 19...





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Responses to COVID-19

- Enhancement focus prior to Covid 19 provided a good foundation for the rapid transition to online/remote
- Government agencies co-ordinating responses across HE
- Strategic planning for short- and medium-term
- Facilitating sharing of expertise and resources across the sector
- Capturing lessons learned through the shift to online/remote T&L







Key impacts of COVID-19 on T&L

Whole sector suddenly has experience of online/remote T&L Better understanding of the benefits of digital AND of face-to-face Digital policies tested by whole institutional communities

Highlighted barriers to learning and importance of universal design Highlighted value of T&L knowledge, supports and structures

Focus on importance of people, collaboration, belonging, wellbeing

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
